


Poinsettia Donations


Are you or anyone you know interested in exploring the Catholic Church as your church home?



<u>Share memories</u>: Share memories of a loved one who has died, or ask someone to share a memory with you.

<u>Communion</u>: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Eucharist take Communion to those unable to attend Mass. Inquire at the parish office about training.

<u>Transport</u>: The OLMC van picks up parishioners every Sunday for the 10:00am Mass. Inquire at the parish office about shadowing one Sunday & consider driving.
