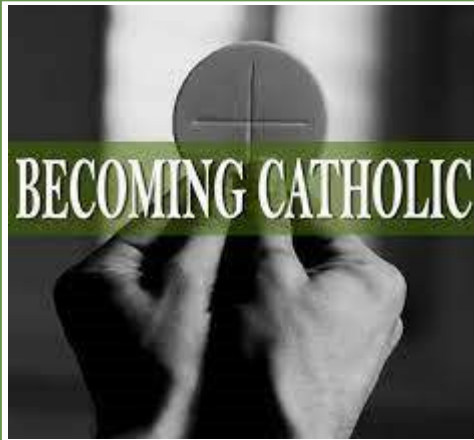

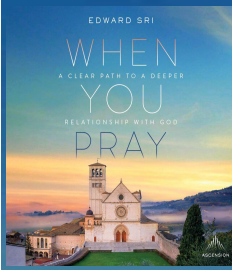

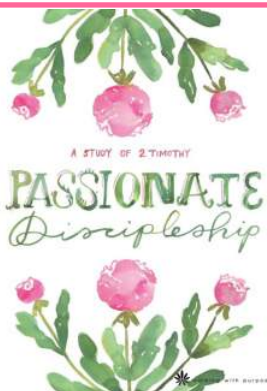

Thankfulness and Anticipation

Catholic Charities of Eastern Virginia has again expressed their gratitude at the overwhelming generosity of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. For the last couple of years, when they have asked us to supply holiday food bags or angel gifts, I always ask if we could help more families than those we are originally given. Your generosity is such that all the opportunities for giving with Thanksgiving food bags or the Angel Tree gift tags would be taken before the 10:00 am Sunday Mass was over.

By heeding Christ's call to feed the hungry, you enabled OLMC to give 50 turkey breasts, 50 bags of personal products and cleaning supplies and 75 bags of Thanksgiving food. There were even more food bags, but we have kept them back for the people who come to us directly.

Catholic Charities were not prepared for the full scope of your generosity and had to get larger vehicles to haul the bounty away.

The Angel Tree gift tags are available this weekend (for those who wanted to shop for the children on Black Friday). Angel Tree gifts are for the children of families whose information is given to us by Catholic Charities. This year we have 400 gift tags. There are several gift tags for each child, and you should be able to identify family groups by the numbering system used by CCEVA. If you take a tag, you must indicate it on the gift logs.

Christmas gifts should be returned by Sunday, December 15. If you don't want to wrap the gifts (or your own family's gifts) you can bring them to the Advent festivities on December 14. More on that next week.

Advent 40 Hours of Adoration

On Friday, December 6, Holy Mass will be offered at 7am, followed by the Holy Rosary, and then adoration in silence through midafternoon.
