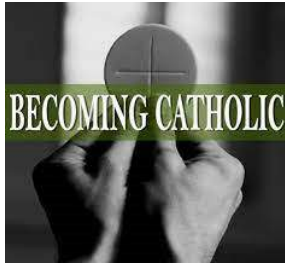

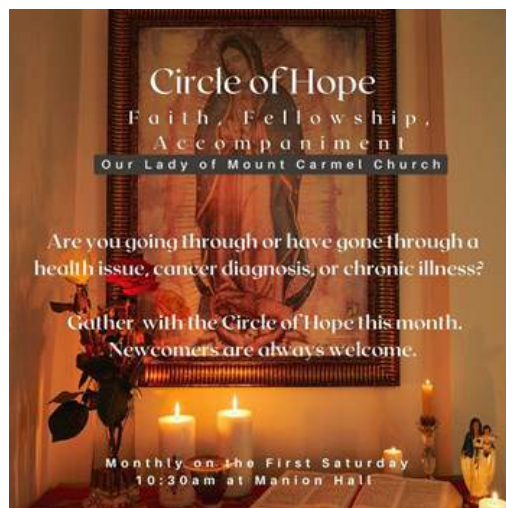
Walking with Purpose

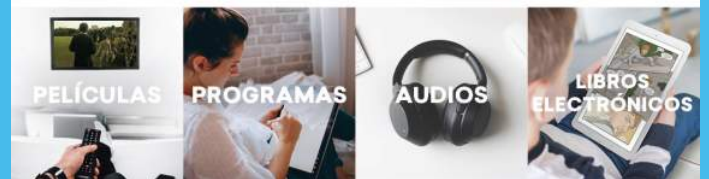
