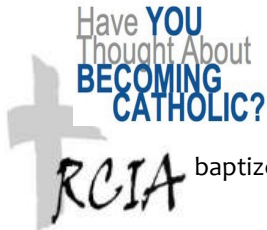

Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish.

This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Would you like to feel more connected with your childhood faith or learn more about it as an adult? Consider attending the Awakening Faith Series.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God’s mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance. A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community. We can assist your return to the active practice of your faith and welcome you back to the Lord’s Table.

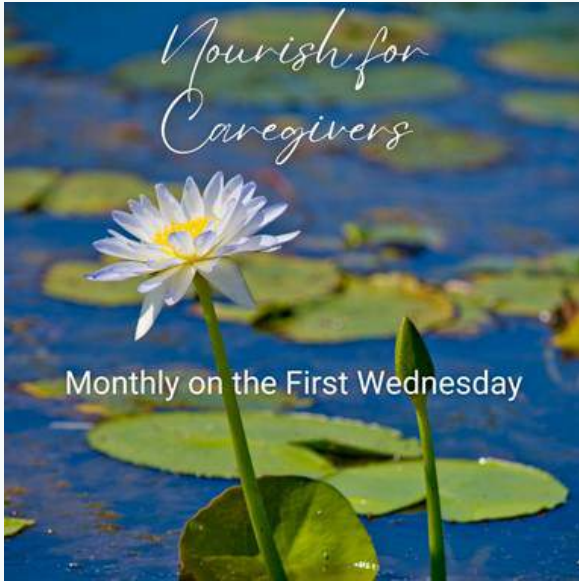


Walking with Purpose

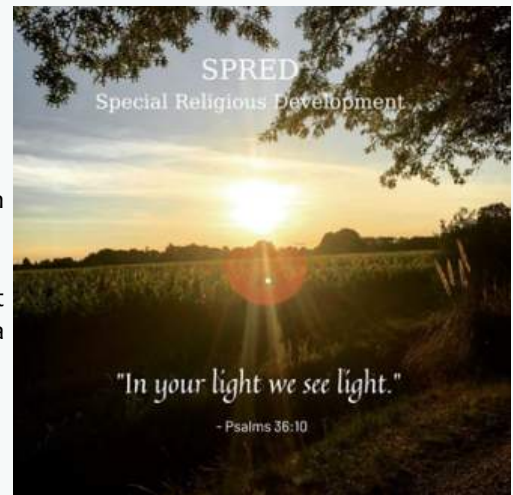
SPRED: Special Religious Development

PREGNANCY OUTREACH UPDATE

LORD, you have probed me, you know me:

you know when I sit and stand; you understand my thoughts from afar.

You formed my inmost being; you knit me in my mother's womb. I praise you, because I am wonderfully made; wonderful are your works!

My very self you know. My bones are not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret,

Our Lady of Mount Carmel is committed to the right to life. One way we “walk the talk” is through our Pregnancy Outreach program that serves parent and children until the child is 2 years old. Over the first half of 2024, OLMC served 75 families with 90 children. Several took advantage of the opportunity to visit every month. Our volunteers gave approximately 300 packs of diapers and wipes to parents, along with approximately 875 outfits of baby clothes, 15 layettes for new babies, and the other endless assortment of baby gear.

This was made possible in large part because of your generosity — giving to the Poor Fund and donating items in kind.
