We are loved from the Cross; we are fed at the Altar; and we are called to carry these amazing gifts out of the church and into our communities. Let us love our neighbors by meeting their needs as best we can.

As many may be aware, Newport News and Hampton have some of the highest eviction rates in the country: they are both in the top 10. PORT was started as a response to the needs created by this crisis. For 20 weeks each year, churches open their doors to provide a warm and safe place to sleep. They are partnered with other churches, who help to feed and clothe those in need.

We are a partner church. Fulfilling our obligations as a partner requires people willing to lead. We are currently building leadership teams for each of our seven nights of service.

The Dinner Lead determines the menu and gathers volunteers who will cook and/or serve and/or clean up.

The Night Lead coordinates with me and the host church on procedures and logistics, coordinates with the Dinner Lead and gathers volunteers who will work to check the guests in and out and to run the clothes closet.

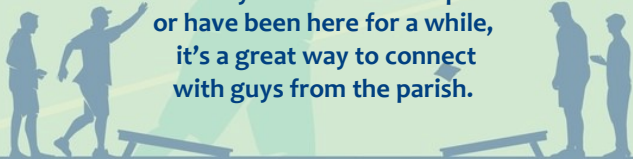
